TEAM RULES, PROCEDURES & CODE OF CONDUCT

TEAM RULES:

1. You are expected to positively represent Central Gwinnett High School in the classroom, computer lab, game chats, bus, or at team and community events. Sportsmanlike conduct and respect for teammates, competitors, coaches, teachers, classmates and officials is expected at all times.
 - 1a. **This includes the use of social media.** Any use of social media that negatively reflects on your teammates, the team, CGHS or the Central Gwinnett Community may result in suspension or dismissal.
2. You are expected to perform well in the classroom, and be on your best behavior at all times.
3. Satisfactory attendance at practice is required. Satisfactory attendance percentages will be set by coaches. There will be a minimum of two(2) checkpoints during the season, after which the consequences below will apply.
 - Event and/or match suspensions until the satisfactory attendance is reached
 - Dismissal from Team
 - 3a. Please be in the lab promptly and ready for game days.
4. Your signature on this document serves as an attendance contract.
5. Attendance for game days is expected. If you have a conflict you must contact the coaches two (2) weeks prior to the match. If you miss your assigned game(s) without approval from the coach, you will be subject to future game(s) or season suspensions.
6. During game day only approved spectators may be in the lab. You are required to sit in your team's area. Do your part in keeping team equipment, the computer lab area, keyboards, mouses, and monitors safe and clean. **Everyone will pick up trash after practices, games, and team events.**
7. You must wear your customized CGHS Esports jersey on game days for GHSA state titled games. All team members will be expected to wear CGHS Esports jerseys or designated attire during school on (or prior to) game days.
8. Parents must be on time to pick you up at the conclusion of practice and/or team events. Practice/Game days end at 5:00 pm. (Smash and League of Legend can last 2-3 hours. Dismissal could be from 5:30 - 6:00 pm)

CONSEQUENCES FOR THE VIOLATION OF TEAM RULES: Violation of the any of the rules above, or other actions that are subversive to good order of the CGHS Esports Program, will result in one or more of the following consequences:

- Verbal warning from Coach
- Contact Parents
- Suspended for one (1) or more games
- Dismissal from Team

CGHS Esports Refund Policy: There are no refunds once payment has been made. We have to register players to a third party vendor. Also, there are no partial refunds. Dues cover seat to play, jerseys, gaming equipment, snacks, and end of the year banquet. Additional funds will come from fundraisers throughout the year to maintain and build the program.

CGHS Esports & GCPS ATHLETIC CODE OF CONDUCT: The Gwinnett County Public Schools Code of Conduct for Athletes goes into effect on the first day a student joins a GCPS athletic team. The Code remains in effect for the entire school year, including when school is not in session. The Complete Code of Conduct is available online or in the GCPS Student/Parent Handbook on pages 21-22. The Code of Conduct includes:

School Suspensions or Criminal Charges
Use of Tobacco (including Vaping)
Hazing
Possession and/or use of Alcohol or Illegal Drugs

Consequences listed below are in addition to any school or criminal consequences. The Coaches and administrators have discretion to set consequences over and above the minimum standards:

- 1st offense = Suspension from team for two (2) matches
- 2nd offense = Dismissal from team

Captains Rules: Captains shall be a returning senior. In the absence of a qualified returning senior then any returning, qualified player will be considered. Captain meetings will be held during the season as needed. Captains will assist the coaching staff in protecting the goals of our team and the values of the Central Gwinnett Community.
